Farrer Elementary is new to Provo School District. The building, built in 1931, was previously Farrer Middle School. It has been remodeled and provides a great location for elementary school learning. Provo Early Education Program (PEEP) and Provo School District Pre-School are also located at the Farrer site.



Curriculum Information

Scott-Foresman is the adopted math series, for all grades. The adopted reading series is Harcourt-Brace, for all grades. Six Traits is used to teach writing. California Early Literacy Learning (CELL) and Extended Literacy Learning (ExLL) are used as a framework to support the teaching of reading and writing in grades K-3 and 4-6 respectively.

Technology

At Farrer, we have two computer labs where students test and work on individual curriculum projects. There are at least two computers available for student use in each classroom. Each teacher has one computer available to him/her at all times.

School Policies

Visitors

Parents and volunteers are always welcome at Farrer Elementary. All visitors and volunteers are required to check in and sign in at the front office when entering the building. You will be required to wear a “visitor” badge while in the building. Student guests are not permitted to visit during school hours.

Checking Out Students

1. All requests to leave the building while school is in session, including lunchtime, must be cleared through the office. Otherwise your child will not be released. You must check your child out at the school office.

2. Upon proper checkout your child will be called to the office, at which time you may take your child.

3. Ill students will wait in the office until proper checkout procedures have taken place.

Student Illness

When a child becomes ill or must be sent home during the school day, the parents will be called and the student checked out through the office. Parents should send notes or make phone calls (374-4940) to the school when their children are going to miss school.
